Police identify O'Fallon, Mo., man killed Thursday in crash on Interstate 64

A man who was killed Thursday when his car slammed into the back of a tractor trailer has been identified as Robert B. Hammond, of O'Fallon, Mo., police said.

Hammond, 50, was driving a 2004 Honda S2000 eastbound on Interstate 64 (Highway 40) in St. Charles County east of Highway 364 when he drove underneath the back of a 2015 Freightliner that was parked on the right shoulder, police said. The tractor trailer driver was not injured.

Hammond was pronounced dead at 1:04 p.m. by St. Charles County emergency management service crew. The crash was under investigation by the Missouri Highway Patrol.
