


This drive will take you up *Hwy. 26* and then around the back (east) side of **Mt. Hood**. Then it is back down the **Gorge** on *I-84* with a finish on the *Historic Columbia Gorge Highway*.




Total <u>Driving Time</u>: 3 hrs. 30 mins. / 158 miles

Find your way to Clackamas. Take I-205 to the Clackamas Exit #12A (Clackamas / Estacada).

Clackamas to Hood River - Driving Time: 2 hrs. 20 mins. / 89 miles



Zero your odometer trip gauge as you leave or pass by the I-205 / Hwy. 212/224 interchange (the mileage points throughout the drive are based on this).



Continue eastward on *Hwy. 212/224*. At exactly **MILE 3** turn **right** on *Hwy. 224*. Passing through **Carver**, bear **right** on *South Springwater Road*, crossing the **Carver** bridge (**MILE 4.3**).

At MILE 6.0, turn left on Bakers Ferry Road. Turn right onto Hwy. 224 at Barton. Just past Barton at MILE 10.5 turn left on Amisigger Road. Go 2 blocks and then turn right on Judd Road. At Hwy 211 (MILE 14.4), turn left toward Sandy.

At **Sandy** turn **right** onto *Hwy.* 26 and head on up the mountain. At **MILE 47.3** you might want to pull into the **Government Camp Rest Area** for a pit-stop. Leaving here you will continue east on *Hwy.* 26 and at **MILE 47.4** take the **right** exit for *Hwy.* 35 / **Hood River**. Once over the pass, you might want to stop at a large parking lot on your **left** for a nice close-up view of the top of **Mt. Hood (MILE 51.3)**.





Continue north on *Hwy. 35* to **Hood River (MILE 88.9)**

Hood River might be a good place to have some lunch and to watch the wind-surfers on the river. The **Full Sail brewing Co.** has a nice restaurant that looks out over the river. [**GPS:** Full Sail's address is 506 Columbia St., Hood River, OR]





Or you could try the **6th Street Bistro** for a full range menu featuring local ingredients. [**GPS:** 6th Street Bistro's address is 509 Cascade Ave., Hood River, OR]





Hood River to Portland - Driving Time: 1 hr. 10 mins. / 69 miles

Leaving **Hood River**, head west on *I-84* toward **Portland.** Leave *I-84* at **Exit 35** (**MILE 117.5**). to take the *Historic Columbia River Highway* past **Multnomah Falls** and up past **Crown Point**.





If there is no parking at **Crown Point**, you can continue on and turn **right** at the **Portland Women's Forum State Park** to enjoy the nice overlook at the **Gorge** and **Crown Point** (**MILE 131.3**).



Then continue on west on the *Historic Columbia River Highway* through **Corbett** and on down through **Troutdale** (**MILE 140.8**). At **Troutdale** you can re-join *I-84* for your return back into **Portland**.

This is merely a <u>suggested</u> drive. You can shorten it – lengthen it – reverse it – modify it – deviate from it or just stay home and detail your car.
